You had asked previously about information from the public consultation process and I would confirm that 991 letters of objection were received as well as a petition containing 827 names and an initial trawl would suggest that the vast majority of the objections refer to the loss of a facility used for recreational purposes including walking, running, cycling and horse riding as well as the loss of a tourist amenity and sightseeing location.
