## Re: Proposed Abandonment of Crockanboy Rd, Greencastle

I writing to you regarding the subject of the proposed abandonment of the Crockanboy Rd, Greencastle.

The Department gave notice of its proposal to abandon a stretch of the Crockanboy Rd on the week commencing $13^{\text {th }}$ June 2016, in the form of a draft order under Article 68 of the Roads (NI) Order 1993. The Department provided for a period of "consultation" in line with the statutory notice requirements set out in Schedule 8 to the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993 to allow for any representations to be made to the proposal.

I am writing to you, as you have made a representation/objection to the proposal. The Department now proposes to modify the draft order which was advertised on week commencing $13^{\text {th }}$ and $20^{\text {th }}$ June 2016. The modification to the order is in the form of an alternative road being provided. Please find enclosed a copy of the modified draft order and associated map.

The modified draft order under Article 68 of the Roads ( Nl ) Order 1993 will be published in the Belfast Gazette on the 22/03/2021; the Tyrone Constitution and Ulster Herald weeks commencing $15^{\text {TH }}$ March and $23^{\text {rd }}$ March 2021.

Please note that your original objection remains in effect, and if you want your objection to remain in place to this abandonment you do not need to take any action.
