**The Crockanboy Road, Greencastle, County Tyrone  
(Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021**

*Coming into operation* - - - - - 2021

The Department for Infrastructure<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) 1993<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order proposes on the completion of works providing alternative facilities for road traffic to abandon an area of road described in the Schedule.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

The Department has modified the Draft Order.

**Citation, commencement and interpretation**

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as The Crockanboy Road, Greencastle, County Tyrone (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021 and shall come into operation on 2021.

(2) In this Order “the Developer” means Dalradian Gold Limited whose registered office is situated at Killybrack Business Park, 3 Killybrack Road, Omagh, Co. Tyrone, BT79 7DG.

**Application**

2. The Developer shall carry out such works as the Department considers necessary and on completion of the works the area of road described in the Schedule shall be abandoned.

Article 2

### **AREA OF ROAD TO BE ABANDONED**

An area of 8640 square metres of road at Crockanboy Road, Greencastle, Co. Tyrone extending from a point 300 metres north-west of its junction with Mullydoo Road for a distance of 1111.5 metres in westerly direction more particularly delineated and shown hatched on Map No. IN1/21/50281.
