Modified Abandonment - Crockanboy Road, Greencastle, County Tyrone

The Department for Infrastructure (DfI) gives notice of its modified proposal to abandon an area of 8640 square metres of road at Crockanboy Road, Greencastle, Co. Tyrone extending from a point 300 metres north-west of its junction with Mulladoo Road for a distance of 1111.5 metres in a westerly direction, after completion of such works as the Department considers necessary for the provision for alternative facilities for road traffic. The area of road proposed to be abandoned is delineated on a modified map which, together with a copy of a modified draft order, may be inspected free of charge during office hours within the period 17th March 2021 to 30th April 2021 at DfI Roads Western Division, Lands Section, County Hall, Drumragh Avenue, Omagh, BT79 7AF.

During the current Covid-19 restrictions, access to this building is limited and inspection of the draft Order and map is by appointment only which can be arranged either by email using droads.western@infrastructure-ni.gov.uk or by telephone during office hours (Monday to Friday 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m.) on 0300 200 7899.
