The Department for Infrastructure (DI) gives notice of its modified proposal to abandon an area of 8640 square metres of road at Crockanboy Road, Greencastle, Co. Tyrone extending from a point 300 metres north-west of its junction with Mullydoe Road for a distance of 1111.5 metres in a westerly direction, after completion of such works as the Department considers necessary for the provision for alternative facilities for road traffic.
